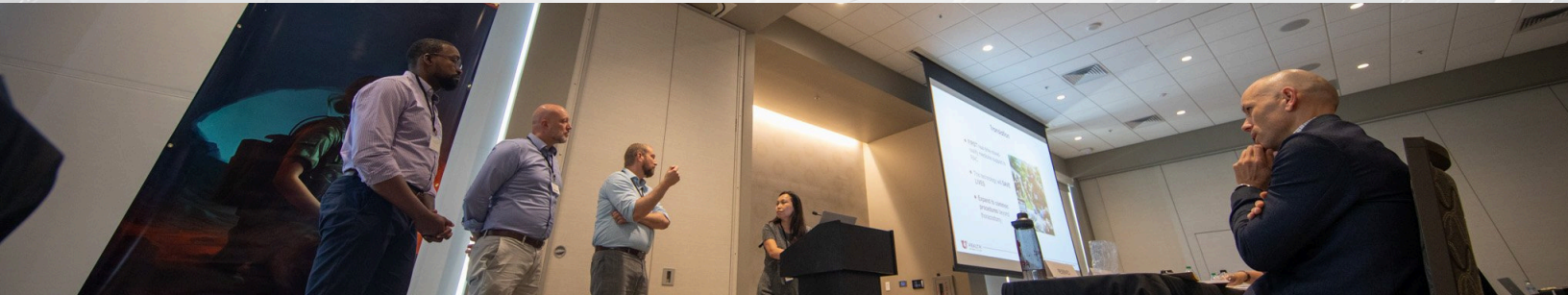




REMOTE & AUSTERE CONDITIONS GRAND CHALLENGE
